BOATING RULES: RETURN BEFORE SUNDOWN

Lake Moc-A-Tek Campground (LMCI)

- 1. Non-swimmers must wear a properly buckled life jacket at all times.
- 2. All children 12 years and younger, must wear a properly buckled life jacket at all times.
- 3. Each passenger must have their own life jacket and whistle issued by LMCG while on the boat.
- 4. No standing up in LMCG boats at any time.
- 5. The person renting/operating the boat must be 18 years of age or older with a valid PA driver's license.
- 6. No swimming or diving from the boat.
- 7. A maximum of 3 people per boat but not to exceed 450 lbs. of passenger weight in any case.
- 8. Electric Powered Boats must carry special PA State licenses which are mounted on boats 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12.
- 9. All fishermen, if required by PA state law, must visibly display a valid PA fishing license on their person while fishing.*
- 10. It is recommended that issued life jackets be displayed in the boat so they can be seen from the shore. *This may prevent a "come ashore" call from the PA authorities.

As the responsible renter/operator of the LMCG boat, I will abide by all of the above rules. Also, I will insure that all my passengers understand and abide by the same rules. If they elect not to abide, I will return them to shore.
